### Mysteries of the Rosary

#### *The Joyful Mysteries*

1. The Annunciation:

the angel, Gabriel tells Mary that she is to be the Mother of God.

2. The Visitation: Mary visits Elizabeth.

3. The Birth of Jesus

4. The Presentation: the baby, Jesus, is presented in the temple.

5. The Finding in the Temple. Jesus is found in the temple teaching the chief priests.

### *The Sorrowful Mysteries*

1. The Agony in the Garden: Jesus prays in the garden before His death.

2. The Scourging at the Pillar: The soldiers whip Jesus without mercy.

3. The Crowning of Thorns: They place a crown of thorns on his head and mock him.

4. The Carrying of the Cross: Jesus carries his cross to Calvary.

5. The Crucifixion and Death: Jesus is nailed to the cross and dies.

### *The Glorious Mysteries*

1. The Resurrection: Jesus rises from the dead.

2. The Ascension: Jesus ascends into heaven.

3. The Descent of the Holy Spirit: The Holy Spirit comes down on the apostles.

4. The Assumption: Mary is taken into heaven.

5. The Coronation: Mary is crowned as the queen of heaven and earth.

1. The Baptism of Jesus

2. The Wedding at Cana

3. The Proclamation of the Kingdom of God

4. The Transfiguration

#### Glory Be To The Father

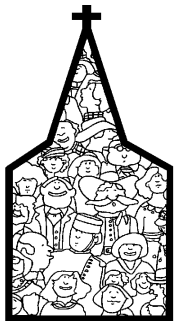
Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. As it is now, ever should be, world without end. Amen

## First Grade

## Third Grade

### Reinforce prayers learned in previous years.

#### The Apostles' Creed

I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth; and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended to the dead. On the third

day he rose again. He ascended into heaven, seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.

## The Rosary

The complete rosary is composed of fifteen decades, divided into three distinct parts, each containing five decades. The first part consists of five joyful events in the life of Jesus and Mary, the second part recalls five sorrowful events, and the third part considers five glorious events.



Begin by making the Sign of the Cross.

While holding the crucifix, say the Apostles Creed, on the large bead, an Our Father, and on the next three small beads, the Hail Mary, then one Glory to the Father on the small chain.

Then say recall the first mystery, say one Our Father, ten Hail Mary's, and one Glory to the Father. This completes one decade. All the other decades are said in the same manner. When you reach the medal at the center of the rosary, say the Hail Holy Queen and finish with a Sign of the Cross.

(Mysteries and Hail Holy Queen learned in 6th grade.)

## Fourth Grade

### Reinforce prayers learned in previous years.

#### Stations of the Cross

- 1) Jesus is condemned to death on the cross
- 2) Jesus accepts his cross.
- 3) Jesus falls the first time.
- 4) Jesus meets his sorrowful Mother.
- 5) Simon of Cyrene helps Jesus carry his cross
- 6) Veronica wipes the face of Jesus
- 7) Jesus falls the second time
- 8) Jesus meets and speaks to the women of Jerusalem.
- 9) Jesus falls the third time.
- 10) Jesus is stripped of his garments.
- 11) Jesus is nailed to the cross.
- 12) Jesus dies on the cross.
- 13) Jesus is taken down from the cross.
- 14) Jesus is placed in the tomb.

Closing prayer recalling the Resurrection.

## Fourth Grade Continued...

#### Act of Faith

O my God, I firmly believe that you are one God in three divine Persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit; I believe that your divine Son became man and died for our sins, and that he will come to judge the living and the dead. #### Act of Hope

O my God, I love you above all things, with my whole heart and soul, because you are all good and worthy of all my love. I love my neighbor as myself for the love of you. I forgive all who have injured me and I ask pardon of all whom I have injured. Amen.
